What you need to know

- about 12,500 students, ideal student town
 location of Passau close to Munich, Vienna and Prague
- **Germany's most beautiful university campus** short distances, close to Passau's city centre

 THE Young University Ranking: ranked best in Bavaria
- international focus / 250+ partnerships worldwide 14 % international students, from 100+ countries

What you need to know

- excellent conditions for study
- no tuition fees
 for both, bachelor's or master's programmes
- 38 degree programmes to choose from
 21 Bachelor's and 17 Master's programmes
- 4 fully English-taught Master's programmes
 - M.Sc. Artificial Intelligence Engineering
 - M.Sc. Computer Science
 - M.Sc. Computational Mathematics
 - M.Sc. International Economics and Business
 - M.A. Development Studies





- Nearly 13,000 students study at four different faculties:
 - The Faculty of Law
 - The Faculty of Business Administration and Economics
 - The Faculty of Arts and Humanities (with the Department of Catholic Theology)
 - The Faculty of Computer Science and Mathematics









When and where do I apply?

When:

- application deadlines
 - 30 June (winter semesters) / 15 January (summer semesters)
- exceptions: master's programmes of the faculty of computer science and mathematics
 - 15 June (winter semesters) / 15 Dec. (summer semesters)

Where:

- most internationals: application via www.uni-assist.de
- applicants from Brazil for the master programes of the faculty of computer science and mathematics: direct application at the University of Passau





What documents do I need to apply?

Be prepared to submit:

- online application plus hard copy per post
- secondary school certificate + university degree certificate
- transcripts of records
- language certificates (in most cases German C1)
- further documents like CV or proof of additional language skills

<u>Please note</u>: Only certified copies and certified translations in German OR English accepted!

Where can I live in Passau?



Many options, at affordable cost

- State-run student halls (in the city, not on campus):
 - monthly rent: 175 335 €
 - apply as early as possible, at the latest by
 15 June (winter semester) / 15 Decembre (summer semester)
- Independent & commercial student halls
- Shared accommodation and student flats
 - monthly rent: 180 400 €
 - usually require a two/three-month deposit when you move in

How much money will I need?



You should budget for a minimum of €865 per month

This amount should cover the following cost:

rent: €250-350 groceries: €150-250 books/other supplies: €50-100 health insurance: €80-90

Semester contribution (payable twice a year): €74,50

student services contribution: €52 semester bus pass: €22,50

There are no tuition fees!
